Here are some ways to alleviate the gate dilemma. We encourage you to choose the best option for your venue or call us at (888) 744-7191 so we can work out a plan.

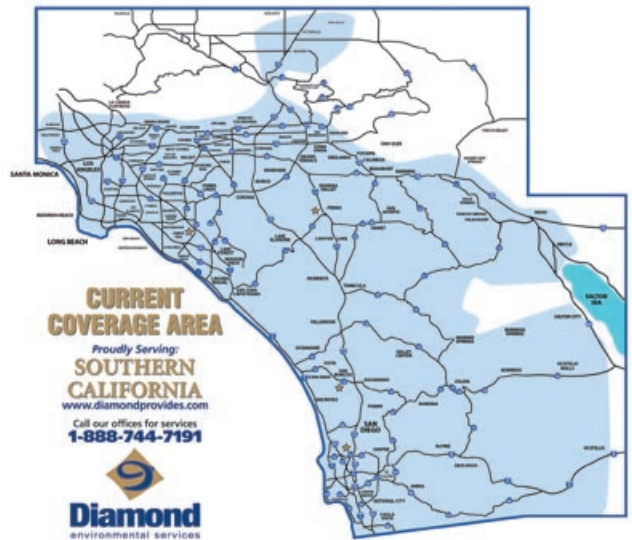
### Gate Access Options
